### Yorkshire & Humber News

**Champion of young people dies.** A community champion who received the MBE and won York's first Community Pride Person of the Year award for his work with young people has died, aged 82:

**Mum of drug addict shares heart-breaking story to help others.** Recent drugs raids on Grimsby's East Marsh prompted a mother to come forward and share her harrowing story of life as the parent of a drug addict: ["She only gets a good night's sleep when her child is in prison"](#)

**The handling of an investigation into the woman who first revealed the child sexual abuse scandal in Rotherham is to be examined.** Jayne Senior has been investigated by Rotherham Council, after a number of complaints. **Young People from North Yorkshire launch their *Make Your Mark* ballot.** *Make Your Mark* is a national ballot running until 30 September in which people aged 11 to 18 across the country can vote on the issues that matter most to them. North Yorkshire's Members of the Youth Parliament (MYPs) are urging young people across the county to take part:

**Are young people still scared to be Goths?** Sophie Lancaster was just 20 when she was kicked to death by teenage boys - all because she was a Goth. Ten years on, have attitudes changed or are young people scared to be different? ['I remember the look they gave her'](#)

## Reports and Publications

**Even cautious teenagers over-share on social media and risk damaging their job prospects, a University of Plymouth study has found.** Posting drunken photographs and personal rants on Instagram, Facebook and Twitter are associated with impulsive behaviour, but study finds that: [Sensible young people are just as likely to post risky things online as their more impulsive peers](#)

**Where is the world's most dangerous country for young people?** The widening gap in youth mortality between the developed and developing world is down to traffic accidents, violence and disease, new analysis shows: [One young person in every 150 there is estimated to have died in 2015](#)

**There has been a 61 per cent increase in calls to the NSPCC helpline** about child neglect over the past five years. The charity said that in 2016/17 the charity's helpline dealt with a record 19,448 calls and emails about child neglect, up 7,338, or 60.9 per cent, on the 2011/12 figure of 12,110: [The full story](#)

## Health

**Doing meth raises the risk of strokes in young people.** People who use methamphetamine are almost five times more likely to have a stroke caused by a bleed in the brain, many of which are fatal. "We can add stroke to the list of terrible and devastating things that methamphetamine does," [The drug can lead to psychosis, and has been linked to anxiety disorders and depression](#)

**Why going dry is the new high for Young People.** The proportion of 16-24-year-olds who are teetotal increased by more than 40% between 2005 and 2013. Today, 1 in 5 is teetotal. ["It is definitely not as cool to be drunk as it was before"](#)
